Information for Customs / Security staff

This patient is carrying Yuflyma® which contains the active ingredient adalimumab, which is a prescription medicine used to treat various inflammatory conditions.

It is not a narcotic or controlled agent.

Yuflyma® is administered subcutaneously (injected under the skin) using a pre-filled pen or syringe. Yuflyma® must be stored in a refrigerator at 2°C to 8°C and should not be frozen or exposed to light. The product may be stored outside the refrigerator at temperatures up to 25°C for up to 30 days.

After this time, it should be discarded regardless of whether it has been returned to the refrigerator.

Given the temperature sensitive nature of the medicine, it is critical that the patient carries it with them in their hand luggage.

Please note that interrupting treatment can seriously impact the patient's medical condition

Tips for trouble-free travelling with this medication

- Ask your healthcare provider to prescribe enough Yuflyma® for the duration of your travel.
- Carry Yuflyma® with you in your hand luggage to prevent sudden temperature changes or baggage loss.
 If travelling to a warm region or country, get advice from your pharmacist about storing Yuflyma.®
- Call or visit the airline website to check if there are any specific rules for travelling with medication.
- If you are travelling overseas, please check if there are any specific rules for entering the country with medication.
- Yuflyma® Travel Kit will help you carry your device with reduced risk of damage or cracking when you travel.
 Always carry this card in the pocket inside Yuflyma® travel kit
- Inform customs staff that you are carrying sharps and a sharps container.
